Re: State Law Requiring Connection to Sewers
Property located at 22 Laroche Avenue (Plat 336, Lot 73)

Dear Mr. Chihoski:

In recent days I have reviewed the status of your connection order and the facts of the matter. Following a check of City records, I see that I stated incorrectly that your property was in tax sale because you had not paid the penalty charges on your utility account. This statement was based on mis-information and should not have been included in the June 3, 2013 correspondence. I apologize for the error.

As stated in correspondence dated November 22, 2010, there is no provision in the law for deferral of the requirement to connect to the sewer system within one year of sale or transfer of the property. Penalty charges continue to accrue. However, once you have connected your property to the public sewer system, you may submit a written request to the WSA Board of Directors asking that the penalty charges be abated. In the past, the Board has abated penalty charges on accounts similar to yours.
