Dear Mr. Hummel,

Thank you for allowing me to follow-up and please note my personal email address. I would also like to thank you for supplying the attachment as I was going to request the form from Town Hall as well in response to your initial inquiry.

As I stated to you when we spoke last week, my legal residence is in Johnston while P. Manzi's legal residence is in another town. As you requested, I do confirm acknowledging the line referencing my affirmation that "I occupy my residence as my principle residence." However, as you know I cannot legally attest to the second statement regarding a spouse's residency without a power of attorney or guardianship. The spouse's signature would have been required on this document to do so.

I do want to thank you for asking the question because it does raise concerns with the form. For example, is it the intent of this resolution to require that all persons who have deeded legal interest in the property to reside at that address, to include life estates? If that is the intent then there needs to be a place for multiple acknowledgements and signatures. The form should also acknowledge relationships other than spouses to include domestic partners and family members. I will be requesting that my colleagues in government form a committee to review the form and make the necessary changes moving forward.
